

Ephesians 3 Worksheet

Paul is remind the Church of Ephesus that he is a “prisoner” and in jail for sharing Jesus Christ. Have ever felt like you were “trapped or imprisoned?” Write in your journal if you can define it.

*Paul understands he is a “servant of the gospel” but he admits he is “less than the least of all the Lord’s people.” Have you ever felt “less than?” Paul allowed “this grace that was give me; to preach to the Gentiles the boundless riches of Christ.” Allow God’s Grace to cover your insecurities or sin that makes you feel less, because with Jesus you are full of boundless riches. My prayer is you “approach God with freedom and confidence.” You are secure in HIM and HIM only.

*I pray this prayer over my children and today I pray it over you. I pray you gain strength with His spirit in your soul, you stay rooted in HIS LOVE, and to know that love surpasses knowledge, and that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

*Do you fully trust God? Have you surrendered everything to him? Write in your journal and really be REAL with this question. Do you believe that through HIM you will be able to do immeasurable more than we ask or imagine, according to HIS power that is at work within us? Do you LIVE that out with your confidence or decisions? Do you question yourself or do you feel rooted and confident because you have Jesus with you always? Do you REALLY trust this promise? Spend some time in the quiet reflecting on how you become more confident through HIM. It’s time to SURRENDER AND GROW!
